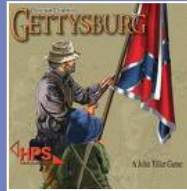

JUNE 26, 2012: TUESDAY

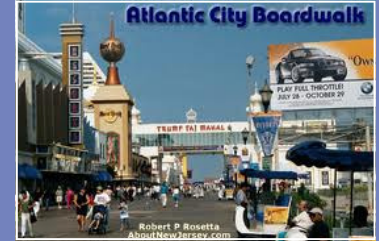
